

XVI Nova Photography Contest – 2024

General

1 – The XVI Photography Contest of Universidade Nova de Lisboa (NOVA), hereinafter referred to as NOVA Fotografia, is an initiative of the Culture and Events Unit of the Rectory of NOVA.

Theme

2 – The competition takes place under the theme: “Freedom”

Terms

3 – The competition is open to all students, from the 1st to the 3rd cycle, accredited postgraduates from Universidade Nova de Lisboa, participants in the SUPERNOVA – Foundation program and foreign students in mobility programs at Universidade NOVA de Lisboa.

4 – Each competitor may submit a **maximum of 3 photographs**.

Delivery of work

5 – Participation is done by filling out and submitting a Registration Form on the competition page (<https://novacultura.unl.pt/programa-category/nova-fotografia/>), until April 8 2024.

6 – The photographs will be sent via a link to download from a cloud, Wetransfer or a similar platform.

7 – The file name must match the title of the image and author.

Jury

8 – The jury will be chaired by the Pro-Rector for Culture of NOVA and will be made up of a professional in the field of photography with a recognized curriculum, by the winner of the “XV NOVA Photography Competition”, by a representative of the Culture and Events Unit and other elements whose presence could be considered relevant by the organization.

9 – The jury will select, according to their quality, a selection of works that will be exhibited and, among them, the winners. The jury's decision is sovereign, with no room for appeal.

Prizes

10 – The following prizes will be awarded (with the jury reserving the possibility of awarding honorable mentions worth €100): 1st Place – €500; 2nd Place – €300; 3rd place – €200.

11 – An exclusive prize will also be awarded to NOVA Cairo students, the value of which is equivalent to the Honorable Mention.

14 – The results will be published on the NOVA Cultura website (<https://novacultura.unl.pt/>) and communicated to the participants.

15 – The photographs submitted to the competition will become part of NOVA's collection, which may use them in exhibitions, publications or other editions, always mentioning the author of the photographs.

Finals

16 – Cases not covered by this regulation will be decided by joint deliberation between the jury and the organization of the competition.

17 – Participation in this competition implies acceptance of these regulations, without reservations.
